3. Community Matters.

a. Public Participation Adjournment.

- Councillor Hand Davis spoke about a project to increase the speed of rural broadband.
- He advised the Council of the pothole hotline: 773555.
- The next PACT meeting is on the 15th February.
- He informed the Council that a Tesco rural bus will not be happening.
- A Speed Impact Device (SID) is due to be placed in the village and Councillor Hand Davis asked where the Council would prefer it to be sited. Sheffield Road was suggested.
- Neighbourhood Pride has purchased two snow blowers for clearing pavements.
- He informed the Council that the NHS 1st responder situated at Penistone Fire Station is rumoured to be withdrawn in the near future. He will inform the Council if he hears more definite details.
- The approval of the planning application at Foxfields was discussed. A section 106 payment was agreed at the planning board for £3000 to be allocated to the Village Green play area.
- Councillor Hand Davis confirmed that Neighbourhood Prides budget will be cut and therefore services won't be as good as they have been.

4a. Minutes of the Meeting held on Monday 10th January 2011, and Matters arising from them.

- The Chair **agreed** to sign the minutes as a true record after **agreement** by the Council (CB,BT). The Clerk had circulated action reports from the minutes and provided the latest update in addition. The Chair and other members reported on their actions.
- The broken wall at the Sidings was discussed. The Chair had seen someone taking measurements a few days ago. It was noted that the wall did not belong to BMBC but had been retained by Barratt Homes.
- The stone wall on the other side of Sheffield Road was discussed again. So much wall has disappeared now that there is a large drop into the field next to the pavement. The Clerk will report to BMBC.
- Councillor Booth informed the Council that Oxspring Heritage Group is going to disband. Records are going into archive. The funds remain and are available to any group in the Parish that wants to do
