2. Prioritisation of Agenda Items.

3. Community Matters.

a. Public Participation Adjournment.

- Councillor Barnard spoke to the parishioners present about the LDF and the Development Sites consultation draft.
- Two sites north and south of Roughbirchworth Lane have been allocated to housing in the consultation document, for a total of 111 houses.
- He explained that the consultation is seeking people's comments to the development sites and that comments should be made to BMBC.
- He spoke about the reclassification of land and that if objections are to be made they must be made based on valid planning grounds. E.g. Flooding, road systems, school capacity, in greenbelt, inadequate access, environmental impact etc.
- He stated that if the landowner did not want to sell the land it would be very difficult for the Council to buy it.
- He stated that now is the time to object to a site as it is in the very early stages, rather than later on when a planning application might be submitted for the land.
- He urged parishioners to send individual letters and explained that "pro-forma" letters or petitions are not usually successful.
- It was agreed to put a link to the consultation and explanation of how to comment on the Oxspring Parish website home page.
- It was agreed to set up a further public meeting and invite the whole village by flyer.
- The Clerk will request that a member of the Planning Policy department attends.
- Councillor Barnard stated that he would attend a further meeting.
- The deadline for comments is the 28th September.

4a. Minutes of the Meeting held on Monday 16th July 2012, and Matters arising from them.

• The Chair **agreed** to sign the minutes as a true record after **agreement** by the Council (BT,FS). The Clerk had circulated action reports from the minutes and provided the latest update in addition. The Chair and other members reported on their actions.
